HALL OF FAME INDUCTION

The Annual Hall of Fame signature program recognizes District of Columbia residents who have made tremendous contributions to the development of our city. The induction program began in 2000. These individuals are selected by expert judges in eleven categories in the following fields: business, civic/community development, communication, cultural arts, education, health, law, politics, religion, science/technology/engineering and sports. The annual gala has been held in April each year. Over two hundred persons have been inducted since the inception of the organization over twenty years ago.





CAPITAL PROBE AWARD

This award is designated for a young adult who has made an impact in the community. It was first introduced in 2000 as the Young Achiever Award. In 2013, the award was renamed the Capital Probe Award. This award recognizes young professionals who are making an impact in their career and the community. These individuals are on track to become our next great leaders.

LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

This program began in 2009 as the Hall of Fame Leadership Academy and was re-named in 2011 for our 2000 Hall of Famer and supporter-Jack H. Olender. It is designed for junior and senior high school students who are on track to attend college or specialized professional educational institutions. Hall of Famers are the resources for the Academy and students attending the Academy have the opportunity to meet and discuss their careers with the Hall of Famers in their respective fields of interest. Discussions also center around course requirements, preparation for college and pitfalls and opportunities in their areas of interest with the Hall of Famers.



FORWARD PROGRAM



The Forward Program will provide opportunities for young adults from 18 to 29 to have a great beginning to their careers. Our participants will receive mentoring, learning opportunities, workshops and internships. They will be paired with Hall of Famers, Sponsors, and Friends of the Hall of Fame. Through the program they will share ideas and leave the program being able to effect change in their surroundings. All participants, sponsors and change agents will be invited to an annual luncheon. The luncheon will provide the participants an opportunity to network and share their learning experiences. With your support, we will give out HOF Scholarships and a DCHOF Improvement Grant.

LIVING LEGACY PROJECT

The Living Legacy History Project will develop an oral and video history of Hall of Famers, Centurions, Tastemakers and influencers who have witnessed or actively participated in the growth of Washington DC. We will use various media to make the information available including a digital tool kit, Hall of Fame website, digital content, teaching tools, and The Hall Speakers Series.

The Washington, DC Hall of Fame Legacy Toolkit will include interviews, history of Washington, information on its Living Legacies, elected officials and activities for kids. The toolkit would include a monthly spotlight that looks at each ward, important dates to the city, includes a look at a different HOF awardee each month and what they have done for the Washington DC area and an event or research project of the month. It will be distributed to area schools as a resource for teachers and students. The filming for the project started in Spring of 2016 and will be ongoing.





SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The annual scholarships are merit based and awarded to District of Columbia high school students to attend the college of their choice or professional educational institution. Recipients are tracked and mentored during their educational career.
